

An Analysis of Slang Words Used in Fast and Furious 9 Movie

ABSTRACT

This research deals with An Analysis of Slang Words in Fast and Furious 9 Movie. The purpose of this study was to determine the type and meaning of the slang used in Fast and Furious 9 movie. The data source is taken from the script Fast and Furious 9 movie. The Fast and Furious 9 movie classified as American action movie released in April 2017 and directed by F. Gary Gray and written by Chris Morgan. The research design used in this research is descriptive qualitative research. This research is described one by one slang words are found from the film Fast and Furious 9 movie by using dictionaries and theories related to slang. From the analysis, there are two types of slang, namely society slang and public house slang. There are 24 word of society slang and 6 word of public house slang. Then the slang word in the form of words and phrases are classified and analyzed. These findings suggest that there are several slang words and phrases in Fast and Furious 9 movie that have been classified into a type of slang. Examples as well as slang words that often appear are *Shit*, *Damn it*, *Guys*, *Buddy* and *Bro*. This study is expected to contribute to the reader to found out about slang clearly. This can help readers speak English fluently. And it can too is expected to enrich new English vocabulary used in everyday conversation.

INTRODUCTION

According to Novari at all (2021: 27) Language is systematic symbol is that used by human to communicate, because language is a tool of communication. People used language to deliver ideas. Opinions and feeling by oral or written ways. Without language, people cannot communicate each other. Language as a tool of communication has important roles in every human interaction. Language is used by people to socialize and interact with other people in society. Without language, people cannot communicate, comprehend, and make a relationship in their society. In communication, there are many styles to convey the language in written or oral form. However, in human daily interaction, oral language is used in every case because it

expresses people's ideas to listeners easily. Through language, people can understand and comprehend what the speaker means. It means that language has many variations in the society which is used by many people in this world. One of the famous varieties of language used by many people is slang words.

Joseph (2011:8) stated movie is a medium that can pour the reality of life into a big screen. Therefore, a film is a show that is in the form of a moving picture and sound and can be seen from two combined senses, namely sight and hearing which aims to reveal a social reality that occurs in the environment. Through film society in all regions and even corners of the world can see the reality that occurs, in this case the film has an effective communication function compared to other media. Movie is audio-visual tool created by people whose purpose is to give information or entertainment people. Many people like to watch movie because it can entertain them, so movie can easily influence people. It is easier for people to copy the culture or language from the movie that they like for instance, American movie. By watching American movie that especially more focus on gangster, mafia, or teenager, people can learn culture and slang that is used by American people, because this movie provides slang therefore, language is never separate from humans, human activities that are not accompanied by language. It will be complicated to determine the parole of a language or not, there has never been a definite number as to the number of languages that exist in this world, therefore an international language is established to communicate among in the world namely English. So, it can be said that English is a language that we must learn. Slang is a type of non-standard language vocabulary and is used in very informal situations especially by certain group of people. Slang is a secret language held by some community groups that are not owned by other groups. The experts can be said Slang is a social variation that is privileged and confidential. Where variation is used by certain circles which are very limited and may not be known by the outside group. The slang words are only known by the group itself; it cannot be understood if people do not know the context when the group says the slang words. It means that slang is used by some communities.

Slang is used in developing countries to communicate with each other. Every country has a slang style based on their languages. The famous countries that mostly used slang words are America, United Kingdom, and Australia because these countries are places for every people in the world to come and also, they study to get science and spend leisure time. People also can learn their language and also their habit from many sources, one of them is a movie. Some people are quite active in forming and spreading slang when they try to come up with unusual words or phrases that express something new or old in a new way and use it in everyday conversations, such as live chat, chat or social media. media networks. For example, people used the words "awesome" and "cool" to describe something they agreed on. Another example is the abbreviation "LOL", which is widely used in direct messages on the Internet, which means "laugh out loud" etc. People find such atypical words everywhere, they are popular not only in informal everyday conversations, but also in magazines, radio, songs and movies. Slang is important for communication in daily life. Nowadays, slang cannot be separated from language because it is part of people communication. Most of people used it for talking to another people.

Although formal language also used by them but they are more regular use slang in daily life. Based on the statement above, slang is one of the most important that having a great influence on the development of language including for student or college student. In the modern era many people go faster to respond new trend language that appears in their environment. Its most enjoy conveying desire by using new language that is slang. Slang is generally used as a means of communication among a group of teenagers during a certain period. This is because adolescents have their own language in expressing self-expression. The using of slang is to lessen the sting of, or on the other hand to give additional point to, a refusal, a rejection and a recantation, to reduce,

perhaps also to disperse, the solemnity, the pomposity, the excessive seriousness in conversation and make enjoying conversation. But slang is not always understood by those around one. Many movie lovers from various ages do not understand the slang language use in a movie, it makes the real meaning of the movie does not reach the audience. Not all the listener or reader understands the real meaning of slang. That is why, to avoid misunderstanding, in this research, the researchers wants to analyze the slang language or slang words that are used in the movie.

During this modern era, slang language keeps involving within youngster conversation and has made its way to numerous forms of media. The television, cell phone, internet and daily conversation are some of the media where youngster used slang language. Movie becomes one of the most effective media that keeps offering the newest slang language, it is use to acknowledge and learn slang language. By watching movies and through the storyline of it, the viewers are able to gain many advantages such as in the form of entertainment, information, knowledge and most probably life lessons. The story of a movie is categorized into two parts: the dialogues and the narration. Movie is a complex form of art; it is due to the language used as the main element to convey the messages to the audience. However, some expressions are difficult to transfer into another language because they are peculiar to that language.

Based on the above statement, this study found slang in the film. The first reason why the researcher chooses this film is that the main characters of the film often use a slang word in their conversation which seems strange to people who do not understand this language and use it in their conversation. Second, because this movie won the Teen Choice Awards in 2017 and the Saturn Award in 2018, *Fast and Furious* is the third best-selling movie in the world. And then the researcher discovered that the characters in this movie speak a lot of slang words, and the characters also used slang words to communicate with each other. The characters in this movie show their customs in America, which means that this movie talks about American culture, language and customs, which not all movies show.

METHOD

The research method of this study used qualitative research. Qualitative research is research that is based on the reality and fact that happened in society. These approaches allow us to build a robust understanding of a topic, unpacking the meanings people ascribe to their lives-to activities, situations, circumstances, people, and objects. Methodologically, these approaches rely on inductive designs at generating meaning and producing rich, descriptive data. Qualitative approaches are most commonly used in exploratory or descriptive research. (Patricia Leavy 2020: 124)

Content analysis is a structured research approach, using specified research designs and methods, to make replicable and valid inferences from texts and similar materials. (Drisko J.W & Maschi T 2016: 8) qualitative was concerned with developing explanation of social phenomena. It was concerned with the social aspects of our world. The descriptive approach centers human being's way in making sense of their reality and attach meaning to it. It was a form of social inquiry that focused on how people interpret and made sense of their experiences and the world they lived in.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

The researcher tries to analyze and classify the selected slang words by grouping them into types of slang, then the researcher tries to explain about the reason for using slang words. The author is looking for all the selected slang words in watching the *fast and furious 9* movie. and analyze every word, by understanding the script. Then, the researcher interprets a set of slang words in the *fast and furious 9* movie.

Based on the classification of slang words, the researcher finds two types of slang used in the *Fast and Furious 9* movie. They are Society slang and public house slang. Both types of slang are often used in films. To describe further, the author tries to analyze the two types. In this analysis, the researcher limits his analysis to only twenty-five slang words because these slang words are often

used by the stars of the movie *Fast and Furious 9*, and also to make the discussion more comfortable. the researcher explains the research findings. The findings of this study are a description of the data obtained in data collection through interviews and documentation.

The data obtained and presented by the researcher will be analyzed by the researcher in accordance with the research results that refer to the formulation of the problem above. Below is the results of the analysis from researcher, namely: After analyzing the data, there were two types of slang word found in *Fast and Furious 9* Movie: (1) Society slang is generally used in everyday speaking and connecting with society. There were 24 (twenty- four) society slang words found in this film are: Buster, Awesome, Shit, Bullshit, Bitch, What the hell, Ain't, Damn it, Yeah, Fucking, By the way, Hell, Shut up, Goddamn, Bastard, Chopper, Asshole, Dumbass. Gonna, (2) Public house slang is generally told about a word used by their community and is not cynical. There were 6 (five) public house slang words found in this film are: Kid, Daddy, Guys, Baby, Buddy and Bro. From the data above, it can be concluded that of the 30 slang words that often appear, namely: Shit, Damn it, and Guys are often used by the actors. Besides these words are rarely used by actors in *Fast and Furious 9* Movie.

Explanations the most of slang words, Guys (25) slang words, Bro (17) slang words, Shit (8) slang words, A'int (8) slang words, Buddy (20) slang words, Baby (10) slang words. So, the total of all the hoses is there: Public house slang (72) slang words, Society slang (16) slang words. This section presents the discussion based on the finding of the study. The discussion is concerned with slang word in the Fast and Furious 9 Movie script. The finding of this study is answering the research problem of the study as follows:

Shit!

The setting was in Berlin, Jarman, a big factory. This word said by Roman. When he is annoyed at Tej for chasing her. It made Roman "Shit!". The quoted conversation.

Roman : Oh, *Shit!* I hate you, Tej!
 Tej : Hahaha

The word "*shit!*" means "**anything bad, poor, inferior, unpleasant**". This meaning has taken from the dictionary of slang. Based on the conversation above, this study assumed that the word "*shit!*" means "**an expression of worry**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang

What the hell

This setting was in the new base. This word said by Letty when she asks what relationship plan, she would do to Mr. Nobody.

The quoted conversation:

Letty : **What the hell** does any of this have to do with us
 Mr. Nobody : Probably nothing, Letty. But I do find it interesting that, apparently, for some reason, she's now working with this guy.

The word "**what the hell**" means "**what happened**". This meaning has taken from the urban dictionary. In this quoted conversation, it can be assumed that the phrase "**what the hell**" means "**what has happened**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation. based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. When Letty asks what relationship plan, she would do to Mr. Nobody. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang

Ain't

This dialogue happened between Tej and Deck in the new base, when Tej argued not wanting to be a deck team and deck refused. These are in the conversation below:

Tej : We are not teaming up with this guy.
Deck : Let's got one thing clear, I *ain't* on your team.

From the conversation above, the word "*ain't*" belong to society slang because based on the theories the word that come from the habitual society of main characters and used in their daily conversation. "*Ain't*" became slang words because based on the theory said that slang is informal language that used by social group. And from this movie the main characters used this word to confirm that something true or not.

Yeah

This setting took place in the new base when Deck is looking for Dom whereabouts information using a tracking device. These are in the conversation below:

Letty : So, you know where Dom is headed!
Deck : *Yeah*, New York.

From the conversation above, the word "*yeah*" means "*yes*". The word "*yeah*" belongs to society slang because based on the theories the word that come from the habitual society of main characters and used in their daily conversation. "*Yeah*" became slang word because based on the theory said that slang is informal language that used by social group.

Buster

The place is on the street (Cuba city). This word said by Dom. when Dom talks to his cousin while fixing his cousin's broken car for auto racing to the person who challenged him to race. The quoted conversation.

Fernando : What are you doing?
Dom : Poor man's turbo pull the vacuum line and hold on. Old trick that **buster** used to play, in case of emergencies.

The word "**buster**" means "**A person or thing that breaks, destroys, or overpowers something**". From the quoted conversation above, it can be assumed that the word "buster" means "a person or thing that breaks". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. Then, the researcher categorizes this word in society slang because it closely related with society. This word is appropriate with the characteristic of society slang.

Shut Up

The setting took place on the race area. This word said by Dominic Toretto. When people make fun of jack driving the car on Toretto is passed of.

The quoted conversation:

People : Talking about me? About to whip your ass, Toretto!
Toretto : **Shut up!** Yeah, you. Want to tell your driver

From the conversation above, the word "**shut up**" means "**silent**". "**Shut up**" became slang word because based on the theory said that slang is informal language that used by social group. And from this movie the main characters used this word to make someone to stop talking much and just drive the car.

Asshole

The setting was in new base. This word said by Hobbs. Where Hobbs was very annoyed and said harshly to deck. The quoted conversation:

Hobb : What are you gonna do, apply for a job? Head *asshole*?
Deck : You know, I think that tight T-shirt's cutting off the circulation to your brain.

The word "**asshole**" means "**Insulting terms of address for people who are stupid or irritating**". This meaning has taken from artikata.com. In this quoted conversation above, this was agreed that

the word “**asshole**” means “**foolish**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, Where Hobbs was very annoyed and said harshly to deck. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Chopper

This setting was in secret base. This word said by Mr. Nobody. He orders to get on a helicopter to find Dom. The quoted conversation.

Mr. Nobody : You guys are gonna get along just great. Which proves rule number two, you never lose everything fire up the **chopper**.

The word “**chopper**” means “**helicopter**”. This meaning has taken from the oxford dictionary. Based on the quoted conversation above, this study was agreed that the word “**chopper**” means “**helicopter**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. Where Mr. Nobody orders to get on a helicopter to find Dom. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Dumbass

This setup is on the new base. This word was said by Letty and Tej while they were adjusting the ridiculousness of the Roman, and Tej said the word. Quoted conversation:

Tej : You’re just a **Dumbass**

The word “**Dumbass**” means “**stupid person; these words are used to express a low opinion of someone's intelligence**”. In this quoted conversation above, this was agreed that the word “**Dumbass**” means “**Stupid**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, Fast and Furious 9.

Goddamn

The setting was in the ice area, this word said by Tej. He talked to Roman who was driving a car and Roman did not hear Tej. The quoted conversation.

Tej : Left and back!

Roman : What!

Tej : Turn the **goddamn** wheel to the left really quickly!

The word “**goddamn**” means “**an expression which used to express extreme displeasure, anger, or surprise**”. This meaning has taken from dictionary of slang. From the quoted conversation above, it can be assumed that the word “**goddamn**” means “**expression irritation**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, where Tej was irritated, because the roman doesn’t listen to it. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

By The Way

The setting is at secret base. This word said by Mr. Nobody. When he comes them in the secret base and asks Ramsey about Vladovin. The quoted conversation:

Mr. Nobody : **By the way**, not so hot.

Ramsey : But there’s nothing in vladovin It’s just ice.

From the quoted conversation above, the word “**by the way**” means “**The term used if we want to change the topic of conversation**”. This meaning has taken from the artikata.com. The researcher categorizes this slang into society slang because it suitablewith the characteristic of society slang, it is usually used in the daily conversation in society. The researcher think that Mr. Nobody uses the word “**by the way**” to change the topic of conversation.

Bullshit

This setting is in the Base of operation, this word said by Tej when Roman says the EMP is took by

Dom. There are in the quotation below:

Hoobs : That sumbitch just crossed us.
Letty : What.
Tej : Wait a second, what are you talking about?
Roman : Dom took the EMP.
Tej : **Bullshit.**

The word "**bullshit**" means "**indirection, hoax or nonsense**". Based on the quoted conversation above, this study assumed that the word "**bullshit**" means "**speak insincerely**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Bitch

This setting was in the jail. This word said by Megan. When he was in the jail and met Tej who was angry with him. The quoted conversation:

Tej : Hobb ! I've been waiting a long time for this.
Megan : Keep waiting, **Bitch.**

The word "**bitch**" means "**an unpleasant or irritating female**". This meaning has taken from the dictionary of slang. Based on the quoted conversation above, this study assumed that the word "**bitch**" means "**an easy woman**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Damn it

This setting was in new base. This word said by Little Nobody. When he is annoyed at the cipher that takes God's Eye to find Dom. It made Little Nobody said "Damn it". The quoted conversation:

Little Nobody : **Damn it.** she wiped it all took god's eye. That was the one thing we could use to find them. We lost everything.

The word "**damn it**" means "**express anger or something rude**". This meaning has taken from the urban dictionary. Based on the quoted conversation above, this study was agreed that word "damn it" means "express anger". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Fucking

This setting was in bar or cafe. This word said by Jacob when Dom meet to his Jacob for help. The quoted conversation:

Jacob : I'll give you until I finish me cuppa. And I'm **fucking** thirsty.
Dom : I've got limited time.

From the quoted conversation above, the word "**fucking**" means "**Express anger or something rude**". This meaning has taken from the dictionary of slang. After analyzing it, the researcher categorizes the slang word "fucking" into society slang because this word has characteristic such as rude meaning and it is often used daily conversation. The researcher think that Jacob is unhappy so expresses his anger by saying "**fucking**" and the word "**fucking**" itself is a type of vulgar word.

Gonna

This setting was in the new base. This word said by Roman when she asks what relationship plan, she would do to Mr. Nobody. The quoted conversation:

Roman : I'm not *gonna* even mention the submarine

From the conversation above, the word "**gonna**" means "**going to**". The word "yeah" belongs to society slang because based on the theories the word that come from the habitual society of main characters and used in their daily conversation. "**going to**" became slang word because based on the theory said that slang is informal language that used by social group

Awesome

This conversation started when Hobbs who at that time is the ball coach for his daughter. This word said by Hobbs. He talked his admiration for his daughter who managed to score a goal.

The quoted conversation:

Samantha : How did I do?

Hobbs : *Awesome*.

Mr. Nobody : Nice Job, kid.

The word "**awesome**" means "**extremely impressive**". In this quoted conversation, it can be assumed that the word "**awesome**" means "**extremely impressive or daunting inspiring great admiration**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. Where Hobbs said his admiration for his daughter who managed to score a goal.

Bogeyman

This setting was in new base. This word said by Tej and Roman. When they said that Dom as bogeyman. The quoted conversation:

Tej : So, bat socially, she`s the **bogeyman**.

Roman : Damn, she`s one of the hottest bogeymen I`ve ever scan.

The word "**bogeyman**" means "**ghost**". This meaning has taken from the artikata.com. In this quoted conversation above, this study was agreed that the word "**bogeyman**" means "**an imaginary evil spirit or being**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation. in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge, when Tej and Roman said that Dom as bogeyman. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Babyshit

This setting was in the new base, when they are used God Eyes' and Mr. Nobody and Dom see little Nobody is busy with his cell phone. The quoted conversation:

Mr. Nobody : He`s still new

Dom : Yeah, Like fresh *babyshit*.

The word "**babyshit**" means "**Baby poop**". This quoted conversation, it can be assumed that the words "**babyshit**" means "**expression of mockery**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge. Where Hobbs mocked Little Nobody who was new. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Hell

The setting took place in ice area (close to the submarine). This word said by Roman. When they find a chip that was on a submarine to lay off nuclear. The quoted conversation:

Little Nobody : We got the chip. No nukes for her.

Roman : *Hell*, yeah. Let`s roll

Tej : Guys, we got company. A lot of company!

From the conversation above, the word "**hell**" means "**impossible thing**". The word "**hell**" belong

to society slang because based on the theories the word that come from the habitual society of main characters and used in their daily conversation. “**Hell**” became slang word because based on the theory said that slang is informal language that used by social group. And from this movie the main character used this word to say that there is no impossible thing if they trying.

Bastrad

The setting was in plane. This word said by Jacob. When he saves Dom’s son from the cipher’s crew. The quoted conversation.

Jacob: You were gonna shoot a baby? You sick ***bastard***.

The word “**bastard**” means “**an obnoxious and offensive person**”. This meaning has taken from the artikata.com. In this quote conversation above, this study agreed that the word “**bastard**” means “**an obnoxious person**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, when he saves Dom’s son from the cipher’s crew. This word categorized into society slang because it is appropriate with the characteristic of the society slang.

Dodgy

This setting was a bar or cafe. This word said by Letty when Dom meet to his Letty for help. The quoted conversation:

Letty: Now, why do I think you’re about to suggest something readily ***dodgy***, Mr. Toretto?

Dom: It’s why I’m here.

Form the quoted conversation above, the word “**dodgy**” means “**Illegal, something’s wrong here**”. This meaning has taken from the dictionary of slang. The researcher categorizes this slang into society slang because it is used in society for informal occasion. In this situation when Dom meet to his Letty for help. Therefore, the researcher think that Letty uses this word to do something illegal.

Ghost Flights

The setting takes secret base. This word said by Ramsey. When she explains about the untraceable cipher plane. The quoted conversation:

Ramsey : How do you think Dom and Chipper got into the country without us knowing ***ghost flights***.

Tej : I thought untraceable aircraft was all internet conspiracy staff.

From the conversation above, the word “**Ghost Flights**” means “**flights that were not tracked or disappeared**”. This meaning has taken from the artikata.com. The researcher categorizes this slang word into society slang because it has the suitability with definition of society slang. The researcher thinks that Ramsey uses this slang to explain about the untraceable chipper plane.

Attaboy

This conversation started when Dom meets Jacob who at that time is the ball coach for his daughter. And told Dom to encourage his daughter. This word said by Jacob. Hobbs gave a boost of admiration to Dom who has given spirit to his daughter. The quoted conversation.

Dom : I’m gonna have all 20 of them line up and kick you right in the tay-tay.

Jacob : Go Dragons!

Dom : ***Attaboy*** go dragons.

The word “**attaboy**” means “**expression of encouragement or admiration to a man or boy**”. This meaning has taken from the artikata.com. From the quoted conversation above, it can be assumed that the word “**attaboy**” means “**expression of encouragement**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie and used in their daily conversation based on the theory of slang by Eric Partridge, where Jacob said his admiration for Dom who has given encouragement to his daughter.

Public House Slang

Daddy's

This setting was in soccer field. This word said by Samantha, she is Hobbs's daughter. When she called her father and asks him to go to work. The quoted conversation:

Samantha : **Daddy's** gotta go to work?
Hobbs : Uh, yeah. Daddy's gotta go to work.

The word "**daddy**" means "**father**". This meaning has taken from the oxford dictionary of slang. In this quoted conversation above, it can be agreed that the word "**daddy**" means "**father**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, when Samantha called her father. This word categorized into public house slang because it appropriate with the characteristic of the public house slang.

Baby

This setting was in the car, ice area. This word said by Tej. When the soldiers gave the bomb but missed because they were running away from the Russian army in their respective cars. The quoted conversation

Hobbs : Left and back!
Roman : What!
Hobbs : Turn the goddamn wheel to the left really quickly!
Tej : Boom, **Baby!**

The word "**baby**" means "**A loving call to someone**". This meaning was taken from the urban dictionary. Based on the conversation above, it can be agreed that the word "**baby**" means "**A loving call to someone**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, where Tej called them using baby. This word categorized into public house slang because it appropriate with the characteristic of the public house slang.

Guys

The setting was in new base. This word said by Mr. Nobody. where Mr. Nobody, Hobbs and others talk about finding a cipher on the fly. And Mr. Nobody call them guys. The quoted conversation:

Hobbs : You're taking my boot right up your ass, is what you're taking.
Mr. Nobody : **Guys**, Guys. the fastest way to find cipher is trough Toretto.

The word "**guys**" means "**An informal term for a youth or man**". This meaning has taken from artikata.com of slang. Based on the quoted conversation above, the word "**guys**" means "**a boy or a person**". The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, where Mr. Nobody, Hobbs and others talk about finding a cipher on the fly. And Mr. Nobody call them guys. This word categorized into public house slang because it appropriate with the characteristic of the public house slang.

Bro

The setting was in street (Cuba). This conversation took place between Fernando and Corneille. When Corneille wanted to take her car. Below is conversation:

Fernando : You know I can't make a living without my car.
Corneille : Not my Problem, **bro**.

From the conversation above, the word "**bro**" means "**brother**". This meaning has taken from artikata.com of slang. According to the researcher assumption this slang into public house slang because this word is closely related with the public house slang. The researcher thinks that Corneille uses this slang to express that Corneille call his friend Fernando.

The word “**baby**” means “**A loving call to someone**”. This meaning was taken from the urban dictionary. Based on the conversation above, it can be agreed that the word “**baby**” means “**A loving call to someone**”. The meaning was appropriated with the situation in the movie, where Tej called they using baby. This word categorized into public house slang because it appropriate with the characteristic of the public house slang.

Buddy

The setting was A Casino in Macao. This word used by Letty, when Letty played in the craps table and it is his turn to throws the dice. Below are the quoted conversations:

- Mya : Can I come over for Thanksgiving? Come on, baby, give me some luck. The girl blows on the dice, and Carter stares down at her.
- Mya : Nice blowing. When's your next birthday, I'll be the cake.
- Letty : Hey, **buddy**, watch yourself. Don't threaten me. I got friends in this town that will bite off your ears. Just sit tight, because I've got the dice and I am on fire! Carter throws the dice.

The researcher compares the common term and the slang term for the word Buddy that the researcher has seen from the dictionaries. In common term the word **Buddy** means “**friends**” and in slang term from the quoted conversation above, the writer knows that the word **buddy** means “**fellow**”, and it can be categorized as public house slang because the suitability with characteristic and the meaning of Public House slang. According to the researcher opinion this word is used in daily conversation to reduce the seriousness in conversation, in this part between Letty and the Mya. The researcher classifies that the word Buddy as the public house slang based on the characteristics of the word connected to theories and the sentence of the script.

Kids

The setting takes in soccer field. This word said by Mr. Nobody. When Hobbs daughter managed to enter a goal and the Mr. Nobody encouraged him by calling him a kid.

- Samantha : Haw did I do?
- Hobbs : Awesome.
- Mr. Nobody : Nice Job, **kids**.

From the conversation above, the word “**kids**” means “**Child**”. This meaning has taken from the oxford dictionary of slang. The researcher thinks that Mr. Nobody uses this slang to express that Samantha is Hobbs’s daughter. Therefore, the reason is to show that one belongs to a certain group. This word categorized into public house slang because it appropriate with the characteristic of the public house.

The Kinds of Slang Occurred in Fast and Furious 7 Movie

The kinds of slang used in this analysis focused on the slang in the form word. The discussion below will be presented in the form of table to mention the word that is categorized into type of slang used in Fast and Furious 9 Movie’s script. It is conducted to make it more understandable and make easy the readers in reading it.

CONCLUSION

There are two types of slang word found in Fast and Furious 9 Movie: 1) Society slang is generally used in everyday speaking and connecting with society. There are 24 (twenty-four) society slang words found in this film are: Buster, Awesome, Shit, Bullshit, Bitch, What the hell, Ain't, Damn it, Yeah, Fucking, By the way, Hell, Shut up, Goddamn, Bastard, Chopper, Asshole, Gonna, Dumbass, Babyshit, Bogeyman, Dodgy, Ghost flights and Attaboy; 2) Public house slang is generally told about a word used by their community and is not cynical.

There are 6 (six) public house slang words found in this film are: Kids, Daddy, Guys, Baby and Bro and Buddy. From the data above, it can be concluded that of the 30 slang words that often appear, namely: Shit, Damn it, Buddy, Ain't, Guys and Bro are often used by the actors. Besides these words are rarely used by actors in Fast and Furious 9 movie.

Moreover, the meaning of slang word in Fast and Furious 9 movie. is based on the type of slang

word used and character background and scene settings. From the analysis in chapter 4 the researcher concluded that the meaning of the slang word is based on contexts. The meaning of slang is taken from the slang dictionary and thesis reference.
